Students may be considered for graduation with Distinction in Research if they, during medical school, significantly contributed to the design and execution of a research project that culminated in the submission of an original article to a peer-reviewed Pub-Med indexed journal. To qualify, the research project must be hypothesis driven. The student's contribution must meet the Hofstra Northwell School of Medicine criteria for authorship (http://medicine.hofstra.edu/about/policies/policies_research_authorship.html) and as such, excludes observational and case-based reports. An application form must be submitted to the Student Research Advisory Committee, a subcommittee of the Student Advancement Committee, by March 1 of the student's graduation year. The Research Advisory Committee will consider each student's participation on a case-by-case basis and invite qualified applicants to present their project and their contribution to its outcome with the committee. A final decision regarding the honor will be made by the committee immediately following the presentation. Please complete the sections below by **typing** in the information requested.
