In order to access full-text directly from PubMed, you must use one of these designated URLs that link to our holdings.

Try searching for the journal title in the *Journal and eBook Finder* from the <u>SOM</u> library or <u>EMIL</u>.

<u>Hofstra Northwell Academic Works</u> is a digital repository created to showcase the scholarly output of the School of Medicine and Northwell Health, including full text access to most materials.

The repository has the potential to expand to include not only articles but books/chapters, abstracts, posters, presentations, and videos. There is currently a seed collection with works from 12 departments online with more being added on a continuous basis.
