Part 1: Enable IMAP and set up your IMAP Password

- 1. From a computer, log in to the Hofstra Portal (http://my.hofstra.edu)
- 2. Click on the Gmail button
- 3. Click on the gear icon



- 4. Click Settings
- 5. Click on the *Forwarding and POP/IMAP* link towards the top of the screen
- 6. Click on the *Enable IMAP* radio button then click *Save Changes* towards the bottom of the page

If you have set up IMAP on a device before and know your password, continue to Part 2. Otherwise follow the instructions below to set up your IMAP password

- 7. Return to the settings section of Gmail and click on the *Accounts* link towards the top of the page
- 8. Click on the *Google Account settings* link
- 9. Click Sign in & security
- 10. Click the word Password under the Password & sign-in method heading
- 11. Follow the on-screen instructions to set up your IMAP password

NOTE: Your Hofstra Gmail password is <u>not</u> the same as and is not connected to your Hofstra Portal password. Changing your Portal password will not update your Gmail password and vice versa

Part 2: Determine your Android version

- 1. Tap *Settings* and under the *System* heading, tap *About Phone/Tablet*
- Under the Android version heading, make note of the version you have. If you have version 4.x or lower go to Part 3a. If you have version 5.x or above go to Part 3b

Part 3a: Set up Android 4.x or below

- 1. Go back to your list of apps and tap Settings. Under the Accounts heading, tap Add Account
- 2. Tap *Email* from the *Add an account* list. **DO NOT tap Google**
- 3. Enter your Hofstra Email address and the password you created in Part 1 into the appropriate fields. Then tap the *Manual setup* button and choose *IMAP* from the list of account types
- 4. Type the following information under *Incoming server settings* and then tap *Next*:
 - Username: Enter your ENTIRE Hofstra e-mail address (i.e. JDOE1@pride.hofstra.edu)
 - **Password**: Enter the password you created in Part 1
 - IMAP server: imap.gmail.com

- Security type: SSL/TLS
- Port: 993
- IMAP path prefix: Leave blank

 - SMTP server: smtp.gmail.com
 - Security type: SSL/TLS
 - *Port*: 465
 - **Username**: Should already contain your entire Hofstra email address
 - **Password**: Should already contain your Hofstra Gmail password

Part 3b: Set up Android 5.x or above

- 1. Go back to your list of apps and tap *Settings.* Under the *Personal* heading, tap *Accounts*
- Tap Add account and then Personal (IMAP) from the list of account types.
 DO NOT tap Google
- 3. Enter your Hofstra Email address and then tap *Manual Setup*
- 4. Under Account Type, choose Personal (IMAP) and then tap Next
- 5. Enter the password you created in Part 1 when prompted and then tap *Next*
- 6. Modify the following settings under Incoming server settings and then tap Next
 - Server: imap.gmail.com
 - Security type: SSL/TLS
 - *Port*: 993
