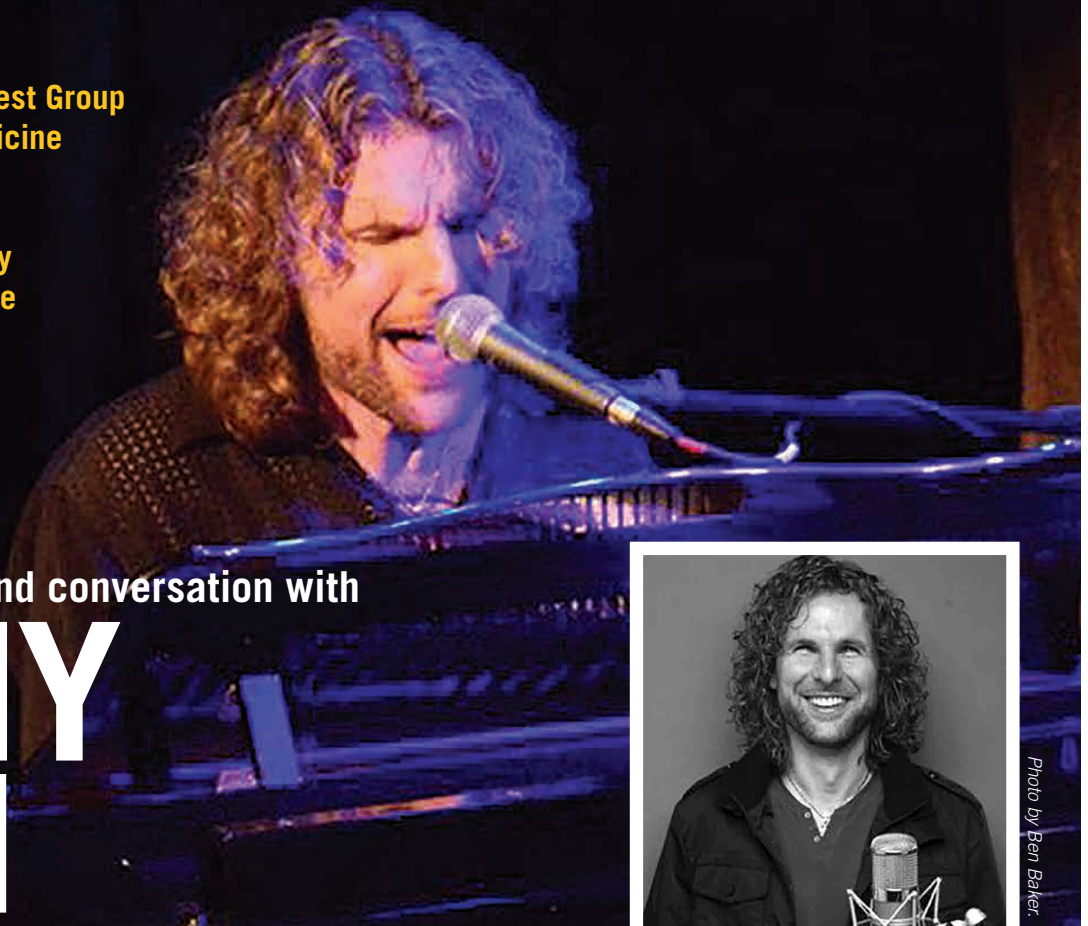

**Danny Kean** – an accomplished songwriter, producer, multi-instrumentalist, and actor – was born with Leber congenital amaurosis, a rare and inherited eye disorder that caused total vision loss from birth. His blindness did not stand in the way of his success. Gifted with perfect pitch and undeterred by obstacles, Danny has toured nationally and internationally, performing music that spans smooth R&B, jazz, early Motown, classic soul, funk rock, and neo-soul. Danny has competed on *American Idol* and was inducted into the New York Blues Hall of Fame.
