Updates to PubMed

There are major changes coming to PubMed in 2020!

First, the behavior of the Northwell Health library icons on PubMed will change starting mid-January 2020. Currently, the icons are only displayed on records where Northwell has access. The absence of the icon typically denotes that full-text access is not available. However, in mid-January **every PubMed record will display a library icon irrespective of whether the library has access or not**. This change means that users will no longer immediately know if they have full-text access, but will have to click on the icon to verify access. If our institution does not have full text access, a page will display that provides an option to order the article and submit directly to the library staff. This will save users the step of then sending a separate email or switching to our separate interlibrary loan form.

Second, the PubMed interface has undergone a redesign. Click [here](#) to read about the changes. The new interface will become the default starting mid-January 2020.

Third, we are in the process of updating the ILL form available through PubMed. The new form will auto-populate the requested citation information. The new form will not be available until later this year.
