BrowZine

BrowZine is an app that allows you to browse, read, and keep track of your favorite journals from your Apple or Android device!

You can create a customized bookshelf of journals, browse table of contents as new issues are published, access the full text of articles to which Northwell Health and the Zucker School of Medicine subscribes plus any open access articles, and save articles in a centralized location.
