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Students may be considered for graduation with Distinction in Research if they, during medical school, significantly contributed to the design and execution of a research project that culminated in the acceptance of an original article to a peer-reviewed journal. To qualify, the research project must be hypothesis driven. The student's contribution must meet the Zucker School of Medicine at Hofstra/Northwell criteria for authorship (<https://medicine.hofstra.edu/pdf/policy/policy-authorship-scholarly-publications.pdf>) and as such, excludes observational and case-based reports. An application form must be submitted to the Advisory Committee for Student Research, a subcommittee of the Student Advancement Committee, by July 1 (for the early cycle) or March 1 (for the standard cycle) of the student's graduation year. The Advisory Committee for Student Research will consider each student's participation on a case-by-case basis and approve the designation.
