



## Using ShareLink for Wireless Collaboration

### What is ShareLink?

- ShareLink by Extron is a device that lets you share content from your laptop or mobile device wirelessly. Up to four users at a time can share their desktop, photos, and videos simultaneously for an ideal collaborative solution.



### Where can I find it?

- ShareLink devices are in all East Small Group Classrooms.

### What can I do with it?

- ShareLink facilitates easy full-screen mirroring for all devices, from Mac and Windows computers to Apple devices, displaying the entire screen for fluid collaboration sessions.  
**\*Android devices are not currently supported.**

### How do I get started?

1. Select *Wireless Laptop* on the Crestron wall panel located by the classroom door
2. Connect your laptop or mobile device to *eduroam*
3. To connect a **laptop** to ShareLink, open a web browser. Type the ShareLink's *IP address/LAN* (see #2 on the figure above) into the address bar
4. To connect your **iOS device** to ShareLink:
  - a. Download the *ShareLink Pro* app  on the App Store
  - b. Open the app, go to the *Manually Added* tab, select  and enter the ShareLink's *IP address* (#2 in the picture above)
  - c. You can also connect your device via *Screen Mirroring*, which doesn't require you to download the ShareLink Pro app
5. Enter the 4-digit login code (#3 on the picture above) when prompted.
6. Your device is connected! Follow the browser or app instructions to share your content.
