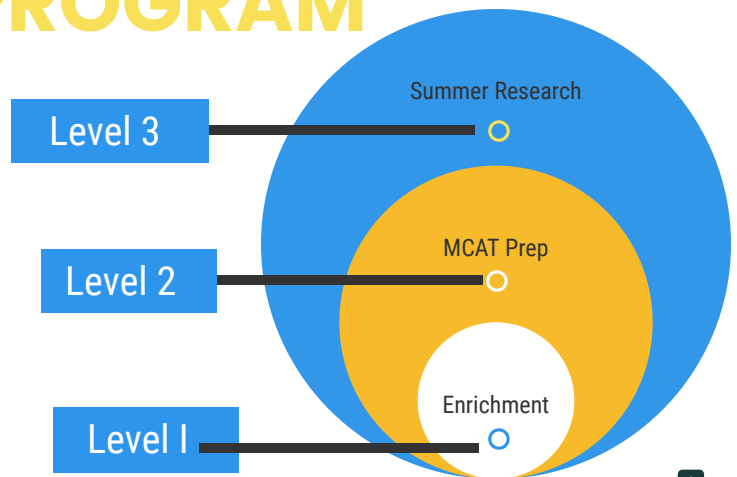
Mission:

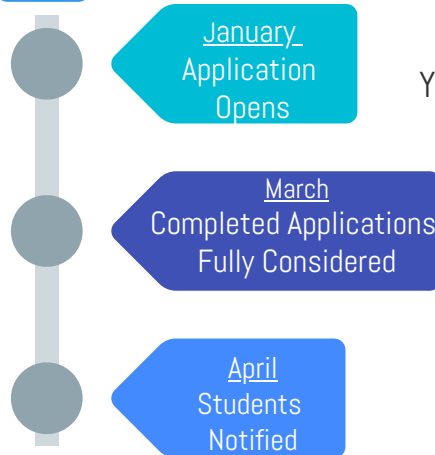
What are the criteria?

- ✔ Strong consideration given to students with GPA >3.2; SAT > 1200; ACT > 25.
- ✔ Completion of college level Biology and Chemistry course.
- ✔ Willing to commit to the three-year program.
- ✔ Must be a U.S. citizen, or permanent resident.
